 $\underline{\text{Section}}\ \underline{6}$ is hereby added to ARTICLE II to provided in its entirety as follows:

Section 6. On July 17, 1986, The Board of Directors made a special assessment of Owners in the amount of \$450.00 for the cost to the Association of pigtailing or rewiring with copper wire the existing aluminum wiring in the Project so as to promote the safety of the Project and its Owners and to reduce the cost of and enhance the availability of required hazard insurance coverage on the Project. The foregoing Special Assessment shall be waived with respect to any Owner who, on or before September 1, 1986, has provided to The Board of Directors satisfactory evidence that such Owner's Unit has previously been pigtailed or rewired with copper wire and that such Unit has thereafter been inspected and approved by the City of Irving.
